

# Penokee Hills Hike

**Saturday, May 26, 2018. 10 AM to 12:30 PM Central Time.**

**ICORE and North Woods Native Plant Society**

Come join us for a 3.2-mile hike from Weber Lake to a scenic rock bluff overlook in the Penokee Hills. This area is part of the Iron County Forest, near Upson, Wisconsin. We'll learn some spring wildflowers as we hike part of the Uller Trail, then head south on a little-known trail to one of most outstanding rock bluffs in all off the Gogebic-Penokee Range. The hike will be moderately difficult, with some up-and-down segments and muddy spots.



## **DIRECTIONS**

Take State Highway 77 to County Road E. The intersection is 0.5 mile west of Iron Belt, 8 miles west of Hurley, and 4.2 miles east of Upson. Follow County Road E 3.1 miles to Weber Lake. Before the lake you'll come to an intersection. Don't go left to Whitecap Mountains Resort. Go straight and then left and park at Weber Lake Campground.

There is a \$5 day-use fee for Weber Lake Campground, including the parking area. The funds support the good work of Iron County Forestry and Parks. \$30 annual passes are available, which also cover Lake of the Falls and Schomberg Park.

Weber Lake parking area coordinates: N 46.40966° W 90.39258°.

**WHAT TO BRING:** water, snacks, hiking boots, insect repellent, camera. Bring lunch if you want to have a picnic at Weber Lake Campground when we return to the vehicles.
